(For mounting to Stainless Steel Sheet Metal, see page 3)

Tools required for installation:

- laser level
- awl (ice pick or finely tapered nail set)
- standard Phillips screwdriver (or electric screwdriver with variable torque setting) Note: If an electric screwdriver is being used, and is torque-adjustable, set it to the lowest torque setting to avoid over-tightening and stripping the screws.



Step 1 - Mark holes for 1st upright.

Step 2 - Punch holes.

- #10 x 1/2" sheet metal screws, zinc-plated

Step 4 - Attach uprights to wall. Do NOT OVER-TIGHTEN. Upright screw

Before permanently installing shelf brackets, please note:

- Single-knob shelf brackets are flanged left or right, and are mounted onto uprights located at each end of a shelving run. To maximize space, mount these brackets so that the flange points <u>away from</u> shelving run (see illustration on front page).
- Double-knob shelf brackets are mounted onto intermediate uprights, if any.
- On uprights adjacent to each other, make sure to mount brackets at the same heights. This will ensure level shelving.

Step 5 - Mount shelf brackets at desired heights to 1st upright.

- Start with end of shelving run (note appropriate flange of bracket).
- Fasten shelf bracket to upright with the two clamp halves, bolt and nut (as shown).
- Repeat for each shelf bracket.





Step 6 - Mount ceiling bracket* to 1st upright.

- Use the same hole-punching procedure as in Step 2. Keep the holes very small.
 Easter the four sheet metal screw
- Fasten the four sheet metal screws through the ceiling bracket and into the ceiling panel (as shown).
 DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.

• Fasten ceiling bracket to the upright with the two clamp halves, bolt and nut (see Step 5 inset).

* Ceiling Brackets <u>required</u> if there is no wall backing or supports.

Step 7 - Repeat Steps 5 and 6 to mount shelf brackets and ceiling bracket onto remaining upright(s).

- Use double-knob brackets for intermediate uprights, if any.
- Use a laser level to mount adjacent brackets at the same height. This will ensure level shelving.

Step 8 - Mount shelving to brackets.

Lower corner collars of shelf onto bracket knobs.



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Tools required for installation:

- laser level
- awl (ice pick, sharp center point, or finely tapered nail set)
- electric drill with 11/64" drill bit
- standard Phillips screwdriver (or electric screwdriver)

Wall-Mounting Hardware furnished:

• #10 x 1/2" #410 Series stainless steel sheet metal screws



Step 1 - Mark holes for 1st upright.





Step 2 - Drill holes.

- Remove upright.
- With awl, center-punch each mark so that the drill bit does not "walk".
- Drill a 11/64" hole at each center-punched mark.

Step 3 - Refer to the illustration above to determine location(s) of remaining upright(s), and repeat Steps 1 and 2.

Note: It might be helpful to temporarily mount bracket onto upright to determine location(s) of remaining upright(s). See illustration above to determine appropriate bracket.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Before permanently installing shelf brackets, please note:

- Single-knob shelf brackets are flanged left or right, and are mounted onto uprights located at each end of a shelving run. To maximize space, mount these brackets so that the flange points <u>away from</u> shelving run (see illustration on page 3).
- Double-knob shelf brackets are mounted onto intermediate uprights, if any.
- On uprights adjacent to each other, make sure to mount brackets at the same heights. This will ensure level shelving.

Step 5 - Mount shelf brackets at desired heights to 1st upright.

- Start with end of shelving run (note appropriate flange of bracket).
- Fasten shelf bracket to upright with the two clamp halves, bolt and nut (as shown).
- Repeat for each shelf bracket.



Step 6 - Mount ceiling bracket* to 1st upright.

- ceiling panel screws ceiling bracket upright (SIDE VIEW)
- Use the same procedure as in Step 2.
- Fasten the four sheet metal screws through the ceiling bracket and into the ceiling panel (as shown).
- Fasten ceiling bracket to the upright with the two clamp halves, bolt and nut (see Step 5 inset).

* Ceiling Brackets <u>required</u> if there is no wall backing or supports.

Step 7 - Repeat Steps 5 and 6 to mount shelf brackets and ceiling bracket onto remaining upright(s).

- Use double-knob brackets for intermediate uprights, if any.
- Use a laser level to mount adjacent brackets at the same height. This will ensure level shelving.

Step 8 - Mount shelving to brackets.

Lower corner collars of shelf onto bracket knobs.





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
